SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES

4.1. Description of First Aid Measures

First-aid Measures General: Animals or persons developing anaphylactic (life-threatening) reactions, such as difficulty in breathing or unconsciousness, must receive immediate medical attention.

First-aid Measures After Ingestion: Call a physician or poison control center immediately. Only induce vomiting at the instruction of medical personnel. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Symptoms/Injuries After Inhalation: No data available.

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4.3. Indication of Any Immediate Medical Attention and Special Treatment Needed

Not for human use. For use in animals only. Treat symptomatically. Persons developing anaphylactic (life threatening) reactions, such as difficulty in breathing or unconsciousness, must receive immediate medical attention. Epinephrine is indicated for anaphylactoid reactions.

SECTION 5: FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

5.1. Extinguishing Media

Suitable Extinguishing Media: Use carbon dioxide, dry chemicals, water spray, foam or material appropriate for the surrounding fire.

Unsuitable Extinguishing Media: None known.

Technical Measures: Comply with applicable regulations.

Storage Conditions: Store at controlled room temperature 68°F-77°F (20°C-25°C), excursions permitted between 59°F and 86°F (15°C and 30°C). Brief exposure to temperature up to 104°F (40°C) may be tolerated provided the mean kinetic temperature does not exceed 77°F (25°C); however such exposure should be minimized.
